_____ C: **Coming Attractions** - Present a movie trailer involving characters from two or more nations. Design a cinematic special effect and original soundtrack to feature in the movie trailer. (Fine Arts)

_____ D: **News To Me** - Using improv skills, create your own original five-minute skit about the cause-and-effect relationship between two unrelated news stories. You'll research different types of news stories and incorporate cooperative human scenery and props in your skit and encounter an unexpected problem. (Improvisational)

_____ E: **Hold It!** - Design, build, and test a structure made of wood and glue to hold weight and contain golf balls. Present a story about a "Captivator" and the weight placement and team-designed delivery system for golf balls. (Structural)

_____ **projectOUTREACH: The World Canvas** - Design and carry out a project to address a real community need, integrating an advertisement and marketing brochure. Share your entertaining live presentation at tournament, as well as an Instant Challenge.
